
The Midnite Youth Theatre Company EOI for Emerging Artists

What is The Lamplight Project?

The Lamplight Project is a 3 day intensive investigation of devising methodologies, for emerging artists 18-25 who want to build their skills, engage in ensemble based performance making, culminating in a one night only, devised theatre production performed at the Subiaco Arts Centre.

Led by WA artist and director, Mark Storen and supported by the Midnite team and industry professionals, The Lamplight Project participants will strive to spotlight issues of interest and concern for young people.

- 2. Answer the following in a short 30-60 second self-tape or written form.

Tell us about yourself:

In one sentence describe the story of your life so far. As a young person, what concerns you about the future?

Tell us about your creative practice

e.g. acting, singing, dancing, digital artist, physical performance, instrument etc.

Tell us about your previous artistic experience

e.g. this is to give us an idea of what you have done

What kind of artistic work resonates with you and why

Note: this can be anything that speaks to you creatively e.g. painting, a poem, a tv show, film, a theatre production, a circus company, a song...
