What should I do if I want to audition?

1. Collect, print and read the **Audition Pack** from the Drama Centre or download from our website.
midnite.ccggs.wa.edu.au
2. Please check your calendar for conflicts. Some absence in rehearsals can be accommodated but this must be recorded on your audition form to allow us to prepare rehearsal schedules productively. Please discuss any concerns with us at your audition.
3. Find a partner and select one of the pair scenes or the monologue attached to perform for your audition. In auditions, the director is interested in your acting ability only.
4. **Book** an Audition time at the Drama Centre office.

5. Work with your partner to prepare and memorise your selected scene. Make creative and courageous character choices. Be playful, bold and imaginative in your approach.
6. Arrive 20mins prior to your audition time and sign in with the Drama Executive to let them know you have arrived.
7. Bring your printed/completed **Audition Form** and wear comfortable clothing so you can move freely.
8. Auditions will be 10mins only in pairs.

CALLBACKS & NOTIFICATION OF OFFERS

If you are offered a callback, you will be required to learn another excerpt from the play. All offers of callbacks will be advised by email or in person at the end of the audition week.

All auditionees will be notified via email or phone of their offer or otherwise at the completion of the audition process.

(If you have a legitimate excuse as to why you cannot make audition dates/times please email the Director jbusby@ccgs.wa.edu.au to arrange another time prior to the audition.

REHEARSALS begin Thursday 6 February at 3.30pm, Drama Centre for ALL CAST Read through.

A rehearsal schedule and a production contract will be presented to the cast at the first read through. Rehearsals will continue every Monday & Thursday (3.30pm – 5.30pm) and Sunday (2pm – 5pm) until performances. (Not including school holidays and long weekends).

Antipholus of Syracuse: Twin Brother to Antipholus of Ephesus

Dromio of Ephesus: Slave to Antipholus of Ephesus

Dromio of Syracuse: Twin brother to Dromio of Ephesus slave to Antipholus of Syracuse

Egeon: A merchant of Syracuse, father of both Antipholuses

Emilia: Lost wife of Egeon and mother of Antipholuses, now an Abbess in Ephesus

Adriana: Wife of Antipholus of Ephesus

Luciana: Her sister

Luce: Her servant

Courtesan: A prostitute

Solinus: The Duke of Ephesus

Balthazar: A friend of Antipholus of Ephesus

Angelo: A Goldsmith

First Merchant of Ephesus: Friend to Antipholus of Syracuse

Second Merchant of Ephesus: To whom Angelo is in debt

Third Merchant of Ephesus: To whom Angelo is in debt

Doctor Pinch: A conjuror

Servant: serves Adriana and Antipholus of Ephesus

Jailers, Officers, Duke's attendants, Pinch's Attendant
